Conversation	Takes turns to participate orally and listens to his/her classmates' ideas.  Effectively expresses his/her ideas about various topics and listens to what is said in the interactions with other people.	
Storytelling Tells anecdotes, following the sequence and order of ideas, with appropriate intonation and volume to make himself/herself understood.		
Description	Mentions characteristics of familiar objects and people he/she observes.	
	Explains what something is like, how something happened or how something works, organizing his/her ideas for ease of understanding.	
Explanation	Answers questions when asked why or how something happened in relation to the experiences and facts he/she is sharing.	
Explanation	Argues the reason why he agrees or disagrees with other people's ideas and declarations.	
	Gives directions to organize and carry out various activities when playing games and building objects.

Reading various narrative subgenres	Talks about literary texts he listens to, describes characters and places he/she imagines.	
Story writing,	Tells familiar stories, talks about the characters and their characteristics, their actions and the places where the events happened.	
interpretation and exchange	After listening to literary texts read aloud, he/she talks about the connection with his own experiences or about something he/she did not know before.

Language and Reading	Differentiates between a letter and a number.  Explores and uses the alphabet when writing.  Introduction to vowels:  • Recognizes, reads and writes the vowels.  Reads the words he/she wrote when listening to the letter name.

Writing	Is able to write the corresponding letter when he/she listens to its sound:  Writes 3- to 4-letter words when he/she listens to the word.  Writes words when he/she listens to the name of a letter.  Uses vowels and consonants to form words and sentences with the teacher's support.  Occasionally, tries to write independently with the teacher's support.  Writes independently with some errors, but text can be easily read and understood.
