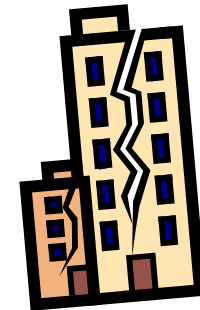

## What to do in case of EARTHQUAKE ! ? ! ?

### **DROP, COVER, AND HOLD ON!**

**Be sure to be in a safe place, and far from windows, or things that could fall. Do not exit your house until the shaking totally stops. Wherever you are, find somewhere clear from electricity posts, high buildings, or trees. REMEMBER TO STAY WHERE YOU ARE (IN A SAFE PLACE) UNTIL THE SHAKING TOTALLY STOPS.**
